Foreword by Heritage Officer, David Griffin

The 2020 cricket season was like no other before it; a late start, a shortened fixture list, one competition removed from the programme altogether, and no spectators. And in Derbyshire's case, every match played away from home.

The use of The Incora County ground as an international venue for both training and matches meant that Derbyshire were unable to play any cricket within the county for the first time in their history, the upshot of which was a relentless two-month travel schedule around the northern half of the country.

The 14-match County Championship disappeared to be replaced by a five-match Bob Willis Trophy based on regional groups of six; the Vitality Blast reverted to the six-team regional groups of old, with everyone playing each other twice; and the 50-over Royal London Cup disappeared leaving domestic cricket without a long form of one-day cricket for the first time since 1962.

New phrases entered the cricketing world – matchday protocols, Covid questionnaires, temperature checks, hand sanitizer breaks – as grounds were essentially locked-down and sub-divided into bubbles for the home team, away team, officials, medical staff, and media.

Everyone travelled separately and nobody could access a ground without completing a questionnaire and recording a suitably low enough temperature check. Once in grounds, there were clear demarcation lines drawn for all present with vastly reduced capacities in media rooms, and one-way systems in place backed up by lines of plastic tape and directional arrows.

On the field, Derbyshire produced two excellent performances in the Bob Willis Trophy, beating Nottinghamshire by three wickets after a record-breaking run chase on the final day at Trent Bridge. Leus du Plooy's 130 in the first innings and Fynn Hudson-Prentice's 91 not out on day four will linger long in the memory, while the three-day win at Leicester was the result of a highly professional and confident performance, notable for a hundred from Wayne Madsen and a match-winning performance with the ball by Matt Critchley.

Rain hampered progress in the following two matches against Yorkshire and Durham and a heavy defeat to Lancashire at Aigburth was disappointing but based on

points accumulated Derbyshire finished a very creditable fifth overall out of the 18 counties.

The Vitality Blast – complete with music – but still no spectators, was not a campaign to reflect on with great affection with just a single victory, at Leicester, from the ten matches of which two were abandoned.

As a member of the media, and present at all matches, it was surreal at times, especially during the Twenty20 games, to be seated in a vast ground like Emerald Headingley or Trent Bridge, with thousand upon thousand of unoccupied seats, as traditional rivals took each other on in fixtures which generally attract capacity crowds.

It was fascinating to be able to hear the vast majority of the shouted conversations on the field, most of which go unheard, particularly during Twenty20 matches.

The novelty of players racing to the boundary to the hand sanitizer stations or alternatively twelfth men racing on with jars of the stuff and firing it into players' hands wore off after a while – it actually became a welcome interlude offering an opportunity to put the camera down and check emails or look at the scores from other games on my phone.

The quality of the cricket didn't seem to suffer for the lack of crowds – maybe it's easier to take a steeping boundary catch at Trent Bridge without 15,000 spectators shouting, "drop it!" – which speaks volumes for the professionalism of all the participants.

Of course, there was coverage for spectators forced to remain at home via the live streams and BBC radio commentaries, and this at least offered spectators an opportunity to witness Derbyshire's season, albeit at some distance.

All in all, then, a season with a difference and one which it is hoped will never be repeated, with the exceptions of the wins at Nottingham and Leicester, of course. Derbyshire followers will surely have been heartened by the continued consistency of the top four, by confirmation that Critchley is a genuine match-winner, and that there are a number of young cricketers all seeking to make an impact after their initial games in 2020.

Leus du Plooy and Fynn Hudson-Prentice starred as Derbyshire began their Bob Willis Trophy campaign with a record-breaking win over Nottinghamshire at Trent Bridge.

Despite playing on the ground of their rivals, Derbyshire were officially the home side, as The Incora™ County Ground was being used to support the return of international cricket in England.

After a frustrating start, in which they failed to take a wicket before lunch, Derbyshire came to life and the new-look bowling attack of Sam Conners, Ben Aitchison and Michael Cohen all claimed wickets to dismiss Nottinghamshire for 324.

Derbyshire also struggled early-on with the bat, but du Plooy's stunning 130, and a gritty five not out from Sam Conners, in a last-wicket stand of 80, helped them to 239 all out.

Conners and Aitchison were the key men with the ball in the second innings, claiming three wickets each, as Nottinghamshire set Billy Godleman and the side 365 to win, which would be their biggest fourth-innings total against another first-class county.

Captain Godleman struck 86, but it was Hudson-Prentice who stole the show, overcoming a thigh injury to hit an unbeaten 91 and lead Derbyshire to victory, alongside the impressive Cohen, who hit 30 not out late on the final day.

Derbyshire win by nine wickets

A first-innings century from Wayne Madsen and career-best figures of 6-73 from Matt Critchley helped Derbyshire to a nine-wicket victory over Leicestershire at The Uptonsteel County Ground.

Both sides came into the fixture buoyed by opening-game victories, but it was the visitors who stole a march on the rest of the North Group by prevailing at Grace Road.

Having won the toss, Leicestershire elected to bat, but a duck from former Derbyshire man Ben Slater, and a freak dismissal of Hasan Azad (6), when he was stumped off the bowling of Luis Reece while standing out of his crease, saw them struggle to 199 all out.

Dustin Melton was the pick of the bowlers, claiming 4-22, but it was the regular sight of Wayne Madsen scoring runs that would dominate the second day.

The batsman enjoyed a 95-run stand with Leus du Plooy (55), and went on to reach his century with a gorgeous straight drive for four.

Critchley then stole the show on the final day, taking six wickets and leading his side to the win, even if a stubborn last-wicket partnership (52) between Chris Wright and Harry Swindells denied Derbyshire the innings victory.

Half-centuries from Billy Godleman, Matt Critchley and Anuj Dal helped Derbyshire remain top of the North Group with a hard-fought draw against Yorkshire at Emerald Headingley.

Godleman won the toss and elected to field, a decision which appeared to be vindicated when Ben Aitchison and Dal claimed early wickets.

However, Dawid Malan swung the contest back into the favour of the hosts, smashing an imperious 219 as Yorkshire declared on 400-6 under cloudy Leeds skies.

And it was those clouds that would be their downfall, as rain came and decimated the match. Dal (78 not out) and Critchley (63) put on a century stand to cement the stalemate for Derbyshire.

The result meant that Derbyshire remained top of the North Group ahead of the penultimate round of fixtures.

The rain was the only winner at Chester-le-Street, as Derbyshire and Durham played out a draw, despite a brilliant century from Luis Reece.

The visitors made a strong start to the match, with Durham reduced to 32-3 after 16 overs, including an exceptional caught and bowled from Ben Aitchison to dismiss David Bedingham (9).

Alex Lees, however, dug in for the hosts and saw them through to lunch, before pushing his way to 84 after the interval.

He was bowled by Reece, while Matt Critchley's crusade to dismiss the middle and lower order prevailed, earning him figures of 4-53.

Trailing by 337 at the start of their first-innings, the opening pair of Reece and captain Billy Godleman (51) began strongly and reached 98 before the latter was caught by Michael Jones off Matty Potts.

Reece continued and reached his first century of the season in 217 balls, including eight fours and one six, before he was caught by Potts off Chris Rushworth for 122.

A pair of attacking cameos from Critchley (46) and Fynn Hudson-Prentice (26) brought proceedings to life late on Day Three, before the intervention of rain throughout the final day put paid to any chance of a result.
