



## DERBYSHIRE COUNTY CRICKET CLUB SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

21 April 2021

To assist our staff and stewards, and to help protect you and your fellow spectators, you are required to follow the below guidelines when visiting our home venues. These measures meet the requirements of current legislation, guidance from the ECB and Safety at Sports Grounds (SGSA) regulations.

These will be different from your last visit and they may also change throughout the summer to comply with the latest government legislation. We kindly ask that supporters are patient with staff and each other as we work to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all.

### SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

- All attendees must carry out their own personal risk assessment, taking into consideration not only age, health status and clinical vulnerability, but also, if booking for others within your social bubble\*, their age, health status and clinical vulnerability.
- Arrive in good time to go through all necessary entry procedures, which may include, but is not limited to: temperature checks, ticket/Membership card scanning, NHS Track and Trace requirements and hand sanitising.
- Wear a face covering, which complies with government recommendations, at all times, unless medically exempt, or when carrying out any exempted activity within the ground.
- Observe social distancing and follow one-way systems as instructed by ground signage.
- To comply with NHS Track and Trace requirements, you will need to choose a spectator zone to sit in, which includes the designated Members Area (*initially the Marquee for County Championship matches whilst social distancing policies remain in place*). You must remain in your chosen zone for the entirety of your visit, using the toilet and catering facilities in that specific zone only.
- We are a cashless venue, with supporters encouraged to pay via contactless methods where possible.
- Supporters are reminded that Tickets, Memberships and Blast Passes are not to be passed to any other individual. Doing so will result in refusal of entry and cancellation without refund.

We all need to play our part. The above conditions have been implemented by the Club as a condition of re-opening and failure to do so impacts on the safety of everyone and will result in the Club taking action at the time, and after the game. This will include:

- Verbal warning(s)
- Ejection from The Incora County Ground
- Ground ban
- Cancellation of Membership without compensation
