Warwickshire v Derbyshire

Match drawn Edgbaston







A strong performance with the bat from Matt Critchley and Harvey Hosein helped Derbyshire to a draw in a snow affected first County Championship game of the season at Edgbaston.

Critchley scored 64 in the first innings after Luis Reece had made 63 at the top of the order.

Warwickshire managed 221 in reply with Matthew Lamb top scoring with 54. The wickets were shared among the bowling unit for Derbyshire with Conners, Aitchison, Cohen and Critchley taking two wickets each.

Matt Critchley's 84 and Harvey Hosein's 78 helped Derbyshire to a score of 244 in their second innings. Oliver Hannon-Dalby took the first five wickets of the innings dispatching all of Derbyshire's top order to claim Warwickshire's second five wicket haul of the match.

Warwickshire required 213 to win in the fourth innings. However, after only five overs the snowfall began and play was suspended which resulted in a draw. Warwickshire were 7 for 0 when the match ended.

Derbyshire vs Worcestershire Match drawn

Incora County Ground, Derby 15-19 April 2021





Despite Matt Critchley's standout performance Derbyshire's cautious approach resulted in a draw against Worcestershire at Derby.

Critchley became Derbyshire's first centurion of the County Championship season with a masterful 109. He was ably supported by du Plooy (98), Godleman (50) and an unbeaten 84 from Harvey Hosein. Derbyshire eventually made a first innings score of 390. Barnard was the pick of the bowlers for Worcestershire, taking 4 wickets.

In reply, Worcestershire made 305, a deficit of 85, largely due to a fine effort from Matt Critchley who took 5-67. The bulk of the runs were scored by Fell (69) and Wessels (60). Alzarri Joseph also chipped in with a quickfire 46 from just 55 balls including eight fours and one six.

Derbyshire replied with 312 for five, Critchley again topscoring with eighty-four including two sixes, ably supported by Wayne Madsen (66) and Harvey Hosein (55).

Critchley, Ben Aitchison and Fynn Hudson-Prentice ensured that Worcestershire's distant target of 397 was never threatened, and at 231-7 Derbyshire had real hopes of forcing a win. However, Cox (60*) and Barnard remained resolute as the game ended in a draw.

Despite David Bedingham's career-best 257 for Durham, Derbyshire earned a draw from this match thanks to a resolute second innings and good performances with the bat from Wayne Madsen and Matt Critchley.

Bedingham, who struck thirty-three fours during his marathon 540-minute knock, helped his side to 475, ably supported by seventy-five from Burnham, as Sam Conners took his maiden five wicket haul, ending the innings with creditable figures of five for eighty-three from 24.4 overs.

Derbyshire's 267 in reply left them well in arrears with Madsen (76), Harvey Hosein (63) and Critchley (40) all contributing as the hosts' Chris Rushworth took six for fifty-eight. Durham chose not to enforce the follow-on, putting Derbyshire all but out of contention by rattling up 175-2 in just under forty-five overs.

A target of 384 was never threatened, but neither was defeat as a 138-run partnership for the fourth wicket between Madsen (74) and Critchley (69) saw Derbyshire safely through to a well-earned draw.

The last day was played cautiously by Derbyshire with survival in mind as Reece (32). Madsen (74) and Critchley (69) after all faced more than 100 balls to ensure Derbyshire claimed a well-earned draw.

Derbyshire vs Nottinghamshire Nottinghamshire won by 310 runs Incora County Ground, Derby 29-2 April/May 2021







Derbyshire were comprehensively outplayed inside three days as Nottinghamshire completed their first Championship win for almost three years.

Having been asked to bat first, the visitors reached 256 thanks to Ben Slater's 107 against his former county, and Joe Clarke's 66, as Fynn Hudson-Prentice produced excellent figures of 4-36 ably supported by Ben Aitchison (3-27).

Luke Fletcher, who took 5-28 was the stand-out bowler for Nottinghamshire as Derbyshire's batsmen struggled against a pacy and skilled pace attack which included England's Stuart Broad. Matt Critchley made thirty-three but Derbyshire's all out of total of 105 left them 151 runs in arrears.

Hudson-Prentice was again the pick of the bowlers, taking 4-40 when Nottinghamshire batted again, but Hameed, Duckett and Clarke all made half centuries as their side rattled up 318 in only 70.4 overs leaving Derbyshire a mammoth 470 to win.

The home side fared little better in their second innings as they subsided to 159 all out, despite a 49-ball half century by Ben Aitchison, batting at number ten. Once against the Nottinghamshire pacemen did most of the damage as they ran out winners by 310 runs.

After no play on the opening day as result of heavy rain, Essex demonstrated why they have been the stand-out side in county cricket in recent seasons with an outstanding batting performance. Scoring at 5.4 runs per over, they made 412-3 in their first innings with hundreds from Tom Westley and Dan Lawrence.

Billy Godleman (45) and Brooke Guest (65) were resolute in trying to defy the home side, but with Harmer always a threat adding three further wickets to his tally, plus three apiece for Simon Porter and Sam Cook, Derbyshire lost their last five wickets for thirty-three runs to lose by an innings and fifteen runs.

Mikey Cohen produced his best bowling figures for the county, taking five for forty-three in Warwickshire's 155 all out leaving the home side requiring an unlikely 308 to win, given what had gone before.

Early wickets contributed to Derbyshire's downfall – 8 for two after five overs - and with nobody making more than Wayne Madsen's 29, a total of 117 left Derbyshire short by a huge margin, Oliver Hannon-Dalby picking up 4-24.

Following-on, Sussex made 187 all out, helped by Delray Rawlins' quickfire fifty-eight off forty-six balls, as the wickets were shared amongst five bowlers.

Derbyshire's modest target of twenty-three was reached for the loss of one wicket, as Critchley, opening the batting in search of the elusive thousandth run, duly caressed the final ball of the season to the boundary to secure a well-earned win.


